

## Downloading, Installing, and Using the VLC Media Player

- 1) Download the VLC Media (VideoLAN Client) Player from their web site. It is 100% free, and is a great, open, video and audio player that functions with many formats, including the one used to send out our audio feeds from **WOFR.org – Word of Faith Radio**. The player is available at:

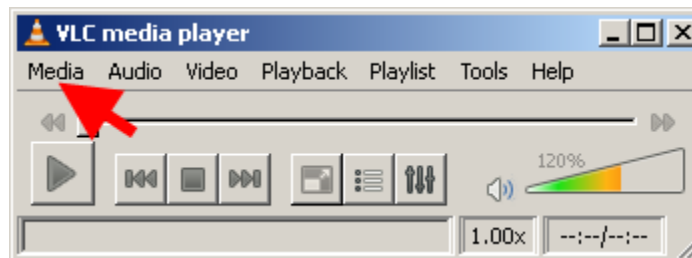

You will see that the program is available for many platforms, such as Windows, Linux, and the Apple Macintosh platform.

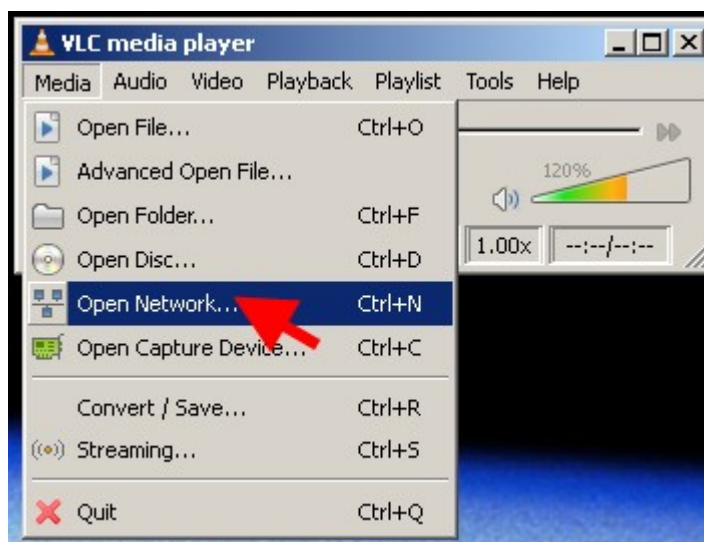
If you have Windows, click on the “Windows” link, and then select a source site (mirror) and click on “Download” and save the installation file to your local PC hard drive, where you will know where to locate it. (Some folks choose to do this to their “Desktop.”)

- 2) Once you have successfully downloaded the software, “double-click” on the file to begin the installation. Accept all the defaults and the software installation will be completed.
- 3) After the program is installed, “click” on the newly installed program to run it. In Windows XP, this will usually be:
- 4) **Start > Programs > VideoLAN > VLC media player**

You will see this screen:

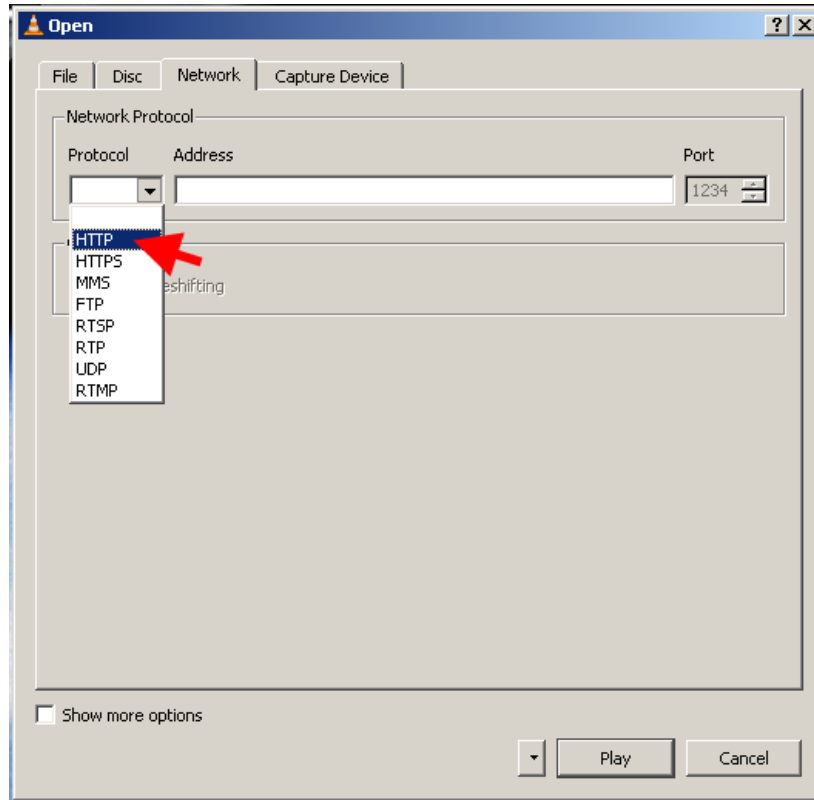


Click “Media” to drop down the menu, as shown below:

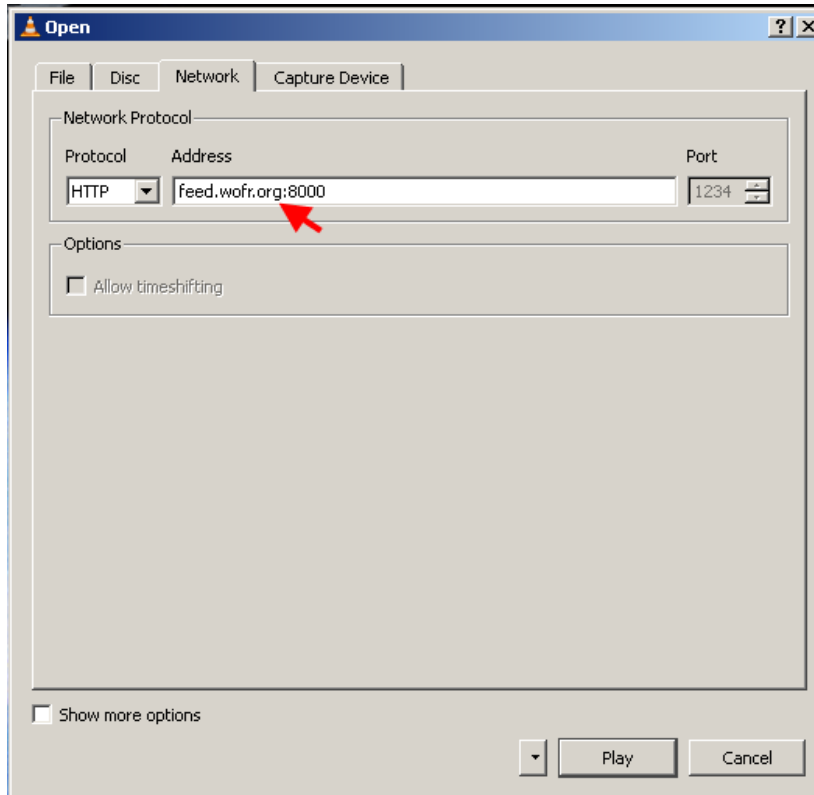


Then, click on the “Open Network...” option.

Select the "Network Protocol" as "HTTP," as shown below:



Then enter in the "Address" field: **feed.wofr.org:8000**, as shown below:



The VLC Media Player will start playing our Word of Faith programming!
